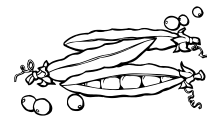

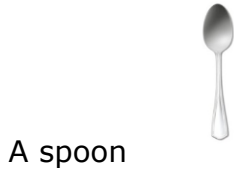


**3. The recipe of mince pies !**
