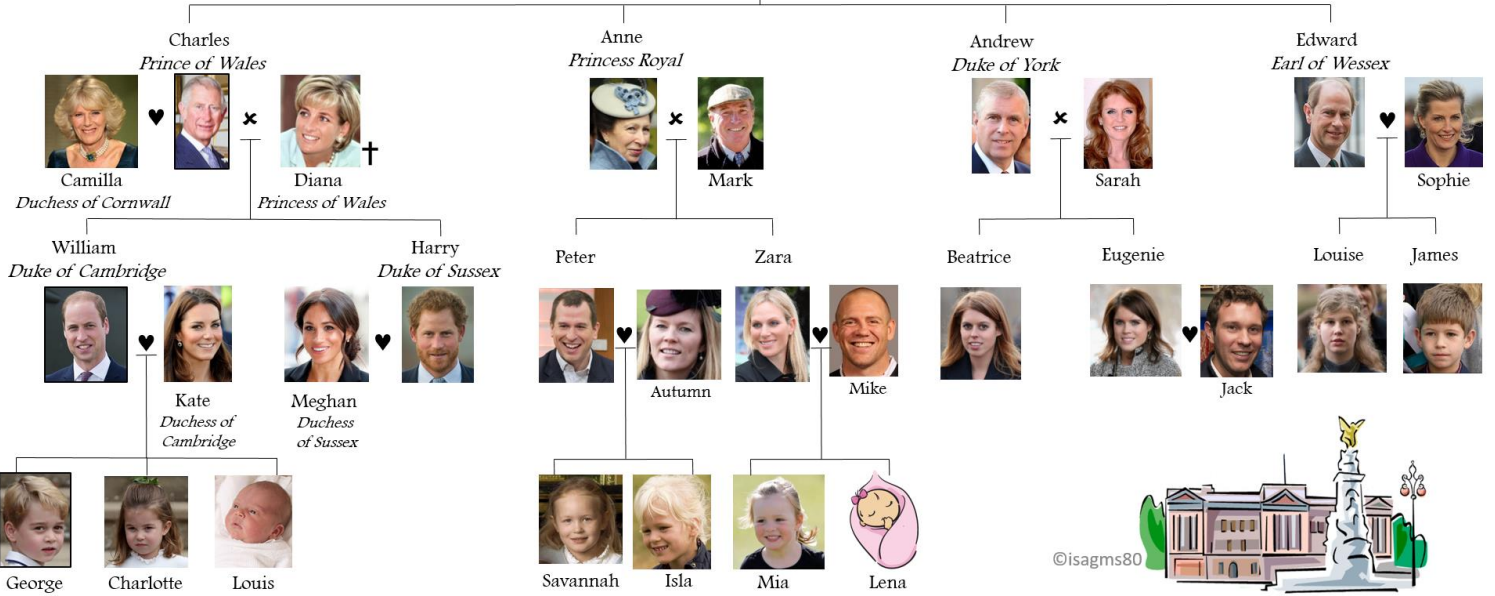




# The British Royal Family
